Workshop Banquet:

Students' participation fee is 1,000 yen. Academic speakers are free of charge.

The fee will be collected at the onsite registration on July 21.

Workshop Overview:

1. Pre-registration using the form on our website is required to attend the workshop. Unregistered, walk-in attendance is strictly prohibited.
2. Only those who can attend the entire workshop will be allowed to participate.
3. Maximum of ~24 participants. The pre-registration list will be evaluated by the organizers, and the results of the selection will be announced later.
4. A variety of the latest microscopes (light-sheet, next generation confocal, super-resolution, etc.) will be demonstrated, with technical support provided by the manufacturers.
5. The timetable of the workshop will be as follows: one day of lectures, one day of rotations, two days of individual projects. Several of the participants will be expected to give short presentations at the end of the workshop.
6. It will be preferable if the workshop attendees bring their own samples for use during the microscopy sessions. Transparency techniques such as ScaleA2, CUBIC, SeeDB, and CLARITY may be useful, but they require sample processing before the workshop. Those who wish to apply these techniques to their samples should discuss this beforehand with the organizers, who in turn will consult with the specialists at the microscopy companies.

Symposium Overview:

4. We are expecting ~18 domestic and international speakers, who will each provide a 40 - 60 minute presentation with discussion time.

5. The definitive schedule of the talks will be uploaded in the near future.
6. The abstracts of the presentations will only be distributed in paper format, and uploading the abstract content to the website is strictly prohibited.

Excursion:

An optional excursion is being planned in the afternoon of the last day of the Symposium (July 27). We will come back to Sendai in time for the last flight to Kobe (~19:00). A small fee for lunch and local transportation may be required. For practical reasons, only those who have registered for this excursion will be allowed to attend. Please use the online registration form if you would like to attend the excursion.

Travel grant:

We may be able to support your travel expenses to Sendai. Those attending both the workshop and the symposium will be given priority, however, we may also be able to support researchers who will only attend the symposium. We would like to support mostly graduate students, postdoctoral fellows, and junior faculty members. Unfortunately, we cannot award travel grants to undergraduate students, although they are also welcome to attend this event at their own expense. The results will be announced in June.
