Agricultural Immunology and Consumers' Behavior

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Katsuhito Fuyuki is a Professor of Laboratory of International Development Studies, and Head of Communication to Society Unit in Center for Food and Agricultural Immunology, Graduate School of Agricultural Science, Tohoku University. After joining Tohoku University, he engaged with agricultural policy, food system and agribusiness, especially focused on rice industries in Japan and other Asian countries. In 1995, he got his PhD on restructuring of rice wholesalers under deregulations of Japanese rice distribution system. His present research interests include restructuring of agriculture by agro-industry and human security issues of farmers in the tsunami-damaged area of northeastern Japan. While he is a board member of Miyagi Consumers Cooperative Association and Miyagi Environmental Life Out-reach Network, he is interested in relationship between farmers and consumers. So his research issues are also slow food, organic farming, and food safety. The accident of TEPCO (Tokyo Electric Power Company) Fukushima atomic powerhouse has caused radioactive contamination on farmland and agricultural products. He attended a large number of meetings with farmers and consumers, considering their better relationship and food safety.
